	I will say when AI helped me with my work.
	I will use AI kindly — never to be mean or to trick people.
	I will ask a grown-up if I am unsure about anything AI does.

Facilitator Notes

For the class teacher. This section does not need to be printed for pupils.

Who uses this	Whole class, teacher-led. Read each pledge aloud together. The class agrees as a group — no individual signatures required for KS1.
When to use it	First week of any unit where AI tools are introduced. Revisit at the start of each new term.
Display	Print A3 and display in the classroom. Children can decorate or add drawings alongside the pledge.
If using P1 AUA	For Years 3–6 (KS2), use the primary version of P1 (Student AI Acceptable Use Agreement) with individual signatures. This pledge is for Years 1–2 only.
Key vocabulary to teach	AI (Artificial Intelligence) — a computer programme that can write, draw, or answer questions. It is not human, it does not have feelings, and it makes mistakes.
